Sports Premium

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum to improve the provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding – provided jointly by the Department for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – will be allocated to primary schools.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

Sports Premium Funding 2015-16

This financial year **Beechwood** has received additional funding, Primary PE and Sports Grant, of £9,621.

How we spend the Sports Premium

We use part of our Premium funding to be a member of the 'Plymouth School Sports Partnership' (PSSP)

The Partnership's mission is to positively impact on the lives of every child attending Partnership schools through the opportunities provided. Through working with PSSP our schools aspire to promoting the Olympic and Paralympic VALUES of Friendship, Respect, Excellence, Determination, Inspiration, Courage and Equality.

Being a member of the 'Plymouth School Sports Partnership' includes...

- Full Plymouth SSP 'Core Offer' including Bikeability, Coaching Days, access to Citywide Competitions, website membership, MTA and Play Leader Training etc.
- Specialist Partnership PE Teachers (formerly PE Release Teachers) to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE (regular visits, at least once every half-term).
- Professional development opportunities in PE/sport.
- 'Family' run sport competitions (at least one per half-term) to engage in competitive sports and activities in line with the new National Curriculum.
- Providing quality assured professional development courses and materials for PE/sport

Additionally, we are able to offer the following by using this funding:

- Release the PE co-ordinator to teach one lesson of PE per week in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6.
- Additional coaches from local teams, such as, Plymouth Albion Rugby Club.
- Pay for PE equipment.
- Employing quality Sport's Coaches.

Our provision for PE and Sport (2015/2016)

This year the children will:

- Take part in weekly PE lessons which will include; Netball, Football, Hockey, Tennis, Athletics, Gymnastics and Dance.
- Have additional coaching from specific sports coaches.
- Be taught dance lessons from a specialised dance teacher.
- Have swimming lessons in Year 4.
- Participate in inter-house competitions.
- Take part in the Plymouth Schools Half Marathon Challenge.
- Have the opportunity to take part in matches, tournaments and festivals.
- Be offered extra-curricular activities including Football, Dance, Netball, Tag Rugby and Multi-Skills.
- Take part in a 'Daily Physical Activity'.
- Participate in a 'School Games'.
- Support cycling course KS2 Bikeability and Balancability in Reception.
- Have the opportunity to use specialised sports equipment as part of the PSSP provision e.g. rowing machines and dance mats.
- Take part in a KS1 Mini Games competition.
- Extend sporting teams to include B teams to increase participation from children.
- To extend participation of SEND children as part of the PSSP provision (Boccia).
- To appoint Key Stage 2 'Sporting Ambassadors' to champion sport throughout the school and enhance pupil voice when reviewing and evaluating provision.
