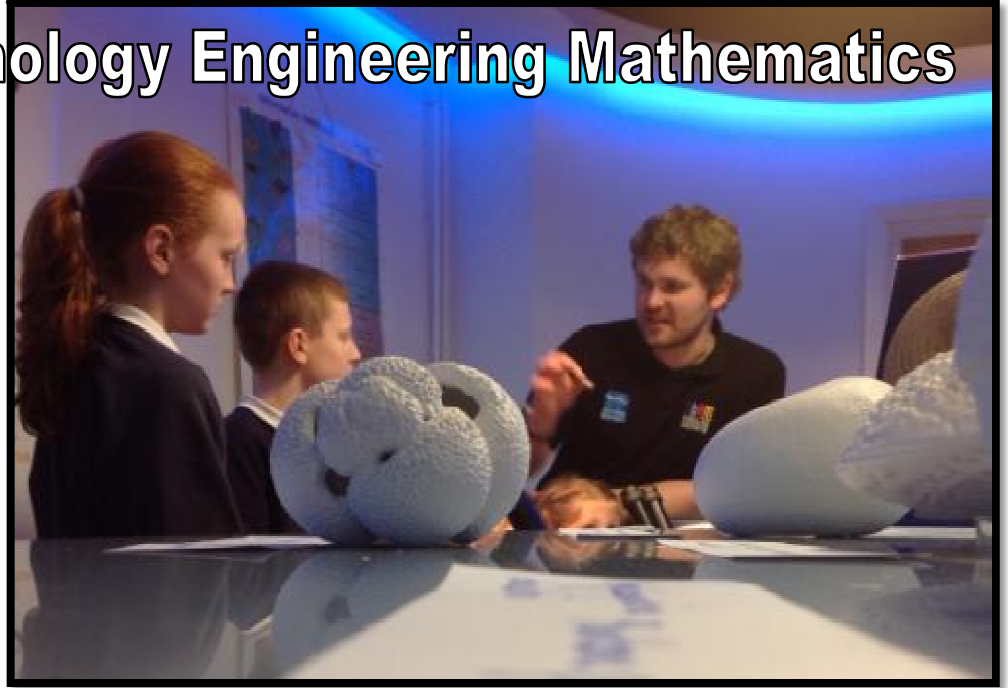


Science Technology Engineering Mathematics
