Shake your Sleighbells we're off to Lapland!



Sustrans are pleased to announce that their winter active travel challenge is back - The Journey to Lapland 2018!

Cycling, scooting and walking are a great way for children to get some much needed exercise during the winter months. As an incentive to get more active this winter, children can pick up a Journey to Lapland Passport and bring it with them every time they come to school before 14th December. If they have cycled, scooted or walked to or from school, they will get a sticker, stamp or signature in their passport. If they manage to get all 12 stops on the way to Lapland filled, they can hand their completed passport to their teacher and receive a certificate.

We are also encouraging families to make a "My School Journey Pledge" for 2019. Think of a way you can change your school journey to make it more active, environmentally friendly and fun and put it into writing, or a poem, rap, drawing, collage - use your imagination! Sustrans will be featuring some of the pledges in their January newsletter and following them up in their Easter newsletter. There will be rewards for children whose pledges are featured! Please return pledges to Mrs Taylor by the end of term.

Winter riding is fun, but it is important to stay safe too. Make sure bikes and scooters are in good working order, especially the brakes. Get children to wear the right gear - waterproof jacket and gloves, and a helmet if they have one. Be safe, be seen, encourage wearing bright colours, reflectives and using lights to be as visible as possible. We are aware that some parents live further away and need to drive to school - why not park 10 minutes away (much easier to find a parking place) and walk the rest of the way... "Park and Stride" counts as an active journey and also improves air quality and safety for children by cutting down on school gate congestion. Why not get your bike out and help your children with this challenge if you are able to. Good Luck


