Miss Woolley made some last minute repairs to the bottom of the boat with the help of parents!



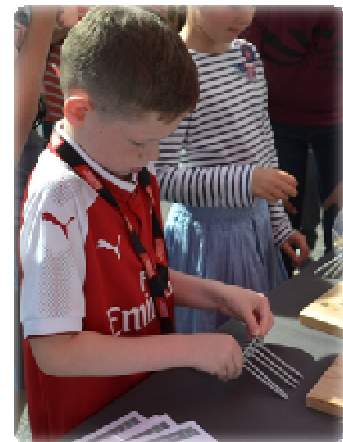
An excited team ready for the race!
