Four children from Year 3 had the opportunity to attend a Math Mastery day at Bishop Cornish Primary School in Saltash. We all enjoyed our day, learning a variety of topics including shape, square numbers and fractions.



One of their favorite activities involved using Tangram pieces to build a variety of triangles – however this game could have been renamed "frustration" as it required a lot of trial and error.

The children also had the opportunity to develop


