

PRESS RELEASE - Plymouth Dads Project launches with Apple Pressing

An exciting new initiative aimed at fathers, grandfathers, uncles, male carers and all father figures and their children is launching on 3rd October. The Plymouth Dads Project if for fathers in Plymouth and the surrounding area who want to have fun their children, both boys and girls, of all ages.

Project Co-ordinator and founder of The Dangerous Dads Network, Ian Blackwell, explains: 'We have been fortunate in securing a grant from the National Lottery Community Fund to run two Saturday dads' group events in Plymouth each month, as well as 'Conversation Cafés' for men on Tuesday evenings. These will all be free events'.

'The Saturday events are open to all dads and male carers and we have planned some great activities, such as apple pressing, Forest School fun with fire-lighting and campfire cooking, making Christmas presents and lots more. All dads can attend with their children, both daughters and sons. Over the years our events have really caught the imagination with families, carers and partners. Events are hugely popular with dads from all walks of life attending to have a few hours of fun with their children and to make best use of the amazing green spaces on offer in Plymouth. Due to COVID restrictions, we do need people to book first. We are also ensuring all our activities are COVID-secure and we will be following the latest guidance'.

'We are really pleased to launch our activities in Plymouth on Saturday 3rd October, starting at 1pm, with an apple pressing and cider-making events at the Hams Wood orchard, PL2 2HP. This is for dads with children aged 5 and over. Then on Saturday 10th October, starting at 2pm, we are running an 'autumn leaves' session at Just Imagine PL6 5DS for dads with children aged 5 and under. Please book by emailing info@dangerousdads.org.uk or phone 07934 739098'.

'We are also hosting Conversation Cafés for men once a month on a Tuesday evenings. These are for dads to come and meet other dads, to talk about the challenges and rewards of being a father, and to get any support or guidance they might need from professional staff. There will also be pizza. The Conservation Cafés are free to attend, but again people will need to book in advance. The first Café event is Tuesday 20th October 7-8pm at Tamar Folk Children's Centre, at Victoria Road Primary School PL5 1RH.'

'Just to remind people, the events will be free and run by experienced workshop leaders. We will have COVID measures in place to keep everyone safe'.
