

We named our body parts and identified where they are. We also learnt how to stay healthy. We designed our very own healthy lunchbox.




In English we read Topsy & Tim start School. We used adjectives to describe the characters and wrote descriptive sentences about them.

We designed, made and evaluated our very own rain gauges! We used these to measure how much rain fall we had – it was a lot!




We also kept a class weather diary. We found that over the past few weeks we have had a lot of rain and a lot of wind.
