Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Finding ways to resolve conflicts with other children to reach a compromise.• Discussing the school's Eight Golden Rules and behavioural expectations in our setting.• Describing ourselves in positive terms and talking about our abilities• Using correct table manners at lunchtime
Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listening and retelling stories• Responding to instructions involving a two-part sequence.• Answering how and why questions.• Expressing ourselves effectively, showing awareness of listeners' needs.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Experimenting with different ways of moving. Jumping off apparatus and landing appropriately.• Handling equipment and tools effectively, including pencils and scissors.• Showing good control and co-ordination in large and small movements.• Knowing the importance for good health and exercise• Using a knife and fork correctly at lunchtime

In our specific areas of learning we will be:

Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Participating in Read Write Inc sessions to segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together.• Beginning to read words and simple sentences.• Writing our own name and other things such as labels and captions.
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Counting and recognising numbers to 20 and beyond.• Ordering two items by weight or capacity.• Finding one more and one less than a group of objects.
Understanding the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Looking at and talking about winter festivals around the world• Talking about winter, spring and seasonal changes• Using the class ipads independently.
Expressive Arts and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Building up a repertoire of songs and dances.• Experimenting to create different textures.• Exploring instruments and their sounds by tapping out a simple rhythm
