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# **11th October 2019**



Following our OFSTED inspection on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> of September, the outcome is that:

'Beechwood Primary Academy continues to be a good school'.

We were one of the first schools in Plymouth to be inspected under the new two day inspection process; the inspectors met with Mrs Evans - Head of School, Mrs Alison Nettleship - Chief Executive Officer, members of the Board of Trustees, the Local advisory board, administrators, curriculum leaders, teachers and the SEN team, as well as seeking the opinions of the pupils and parents during the visit. The inspector also conducted lesson observations, work scrutinies and looked at the school's key documents. We are very proud of the children for the way they conducted themselves throughout the inspection, they were their usual polite and respectful selves and a credit to our community. Well done children!

Discovery Multi Academy Trust now has three good schools under the leadership of Alison Nettleship - CEO, as Beechwood Primary Academy now joins Oakwood Primary Academy and Weston Mill Community Academy with the 'Good' rating following their inspections earlier this year.

I would like to thank the whole team at Beechwood for their hard work, care and determination in ensuring that the children have the best possible start to their school career and also the parents for their support during the inspection and through the year.
