In order to provide electronic consent for your child's Flu vaccination, please can we request that you access the consent portal via the following link below and follow the on-line instructions.

Please register your child by **27th October 2019**. This is to ensure our nurses have sufficient time to clinically assess the information. This link is secure and unique to your child's school. Full details and information to assist you in completing the electronic consent is detailed on the consent portal including full FAQ's, patient information and contact details should you wish to speak to one of the school Immunisation Nurses regarding the nasal vaccination.
