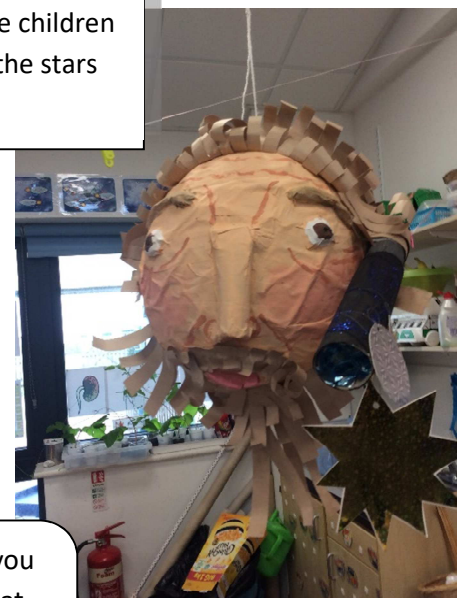


We made our totem pole head of Galileo to display with the rest of the school Scientists. The children also enjoyed making telescopes to see the stars with, just like Galileo!
