RE: Plymouth Half Marathon - Sunday 19th June

It is great to see children working hard to complete their 12.1 miles prior to the Plymouth Half Marathon event. They have been attending running club, participating in daily miles and some children have even been completing extra practice at home.

It is nearly time for children to complete their final mile and receive their well-earned medal. Please see below, race day information provided by the organisers.

Please also complete the medical conditions form on the attached page. If your child requires medication that will need to be administered at the race, please complete a green form from the office and bring the medication with the form to the meeting point on the day.

Meeting Points

- School adults will meet children at the parent drop off point (see map on the back) at 10.45am. We need to have the whole group ready by 11.15am.
- Children will participate in a warmup before the start of the Schools' Challenge at 11:45am.
- On completion of the run, children will be presented with their medal and asked to collect a snack and bottle of water before returning to their school area.
- School adults and children will meet in the Holding Area once again after the Challenge. We will then sign children out and take them to meet parents (approx.12:15).
- PLEASE NOTE NO PARENTS ARE ALLOWED IN THE SCHOOL'S CHALLENGE AREA.

Clothing and belongings

- Children will be given their t-shirts and race numbers at school prior to the event. They must wear their event t-shirts and race numbers for the race. These MUST be clearly visible on entry to the challenge area to ensure a speedy entrance. These will be handed out next week.
- All children MUST fill in the details on the back of their race number and wear this on their front.

Travel Arrangements:

Britain's Ocean City Running Festival is staged on closed roads, which will inevitably cause some disruption. Please take note of road traffic operatives and signage.
