How you can help:



Reading, number bonds and spellings are the main areas you can make a huge difference with at home, and these are what we expect the children to complete as homework each week. Reading books are changed when the children are ready to change their books in school and they have a Reading Journal that they can bring backwards and forwards from school to track their reading at home. Children are still using the Renaissance Reading program. Children should try to read with an adult every day; a good guide is 20 mins per day. It is even more helpful if you can ask them questions about what they have been reading, or to predict what they think will happen next.

Each week, your child will be given a list of spellings for their age group. They are tested once a week, on a Friday. You can really support your child by helping them to learn their spellings at home. A few minutes each evening or as you are walking to or from school will make all the difference.

Children in YI will learn number bonds. These are number bonds up to 20 and it is important to regularly practise. They are also learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s forwards and backwards from any given number.

<u>PE</u>

The children will continue to participate in PE sessions each week. Our topic this term is 'Health and Fitness'. **On our PE day, Tuesday, children will be required to come** to school in their PE kit for the day. The children will be going outside and will need suitable outside kit including trainers or plimsolls. School PE kit is a white t-shirt, black or blue shorts, clean socks and trainers or plimsolls. Earrings must be removed for PE by the child, or not worn to school on that day please. Our usual PE day will be **Tuesday**; however, we may take part in other outdoor activities during the week, which will be completed in school uniform.

Religious Education

All year groups study a range of religious beliefs in a knowledge capacity. In terms 5 and 6, we will explore 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?', and 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?'
