ECO TEAM MEETING


At the ECO Team meeting yesterday, the children discussed where we can reduce the impact on the World at Christmas.

Younger children will not be able to attend the Wednesday performance, but are welcome to come along to the dress rehearsal on **Tuesday 17th December at 2pm.**






